Monday, November 17, 2025**

Present: Selectmen Les Babb, Alan Fall, Gary Williams, and Stacy Bolduc, Town Administrator, who recorded the minutes. This meeting was held at the Town Office. Babb called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Review of Mail, Sign Manifests, and Approval of Minutes

Department Head Update

Highway- Scott updated the Board that he priced GMC Duramax diesel ¾-ton truck with a cab and a ½. with an 8' bed. The cost is \$67,945 and does not include plow hook-up. The bid came from DiPrizio Motors. Les asked Scott to look at the State bids. Passing the old truck onto the Zoning Officer was discussed. The old truck needs work to get inspected. The board directed Scott to have the work done on the old truck so it would pass inspection. The winter parking ban is in effect. Stacy asked whether Board wanted no littering signs posted at the entrance to Square Brook, where people are dumping in the town's right- of- way. Les would like Alan Libby to look at what's there now to see if he recognizes it. Scott said in the past, the signs had been stolen.

Scott has held off on ordering salt because the price has gone up \$3.00 a ton. The winter budget was reviewed to see what is left to purchase the salt. Warrant articles were reviewed. It was agreed to keep the 550 for the winter and fix it to pass inspection.
